**Bottoms: Navy, khaki/tan, black or jeans**

- shorts, pants, skorts, skirts, skirted jumpers
- must be plain, solid-color twill, corduroy or denim fabric;
- **NO** holes or cut offs allowed.

**Tops: White, burgundy or navy with collar**

- must have long or short sleeves
- knit polo-type or woven dress shirts, blouses, turtlenecks
- School t-shirts are OK (available in the school office) \*

***We now have blue and pink spirit shirts available  
(these colors are only appropriate with school shirts)***

**Other dress code rules**

- a **belt is required** if the garment has belt loops
- shirts (including t-shirts) must be tucked in
- hooded sweatshirts are allowed but **must** comply with school top policy – solid burgundy, white or navy
- shorts/skirts must be mid-thigh or longer
- clothing or footwear that is construed by the principal or designee as hazardous or dangerous to the health of the student or others can be prohibited
- clothes must be appropriate size, with waist of garment worn at student's waist; clothing that is too tight or too loose is not appropriate for school
- school administrators will determine if clothing is appropriate for school and complies with district rules
- **MANDATORY** tennis shoes on PE days
